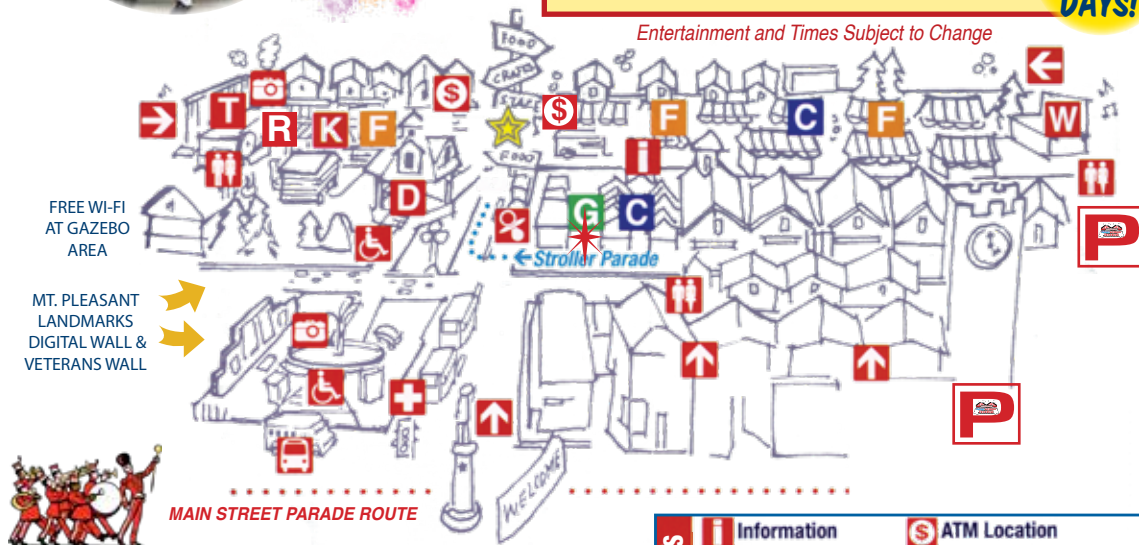
ETHNIC FOODS... It's the variety and the smell of freshly
